Registration on www.sportdata.org

The registration needs to include following information:

- Online registration of the athletes on Sportdata
- Name of official Coach
- Name of Referee
- > Name of official representative (maximum 2 people, e.g. president of the association and technical director)
- > Name of photographer & press (maximum 2 people: 1 photographer, 1 press)

Access to the competition area is only granted for owners of athletes- or coach-cards, wearing Karate Gi or track suit as well as other accredited persons (officials, press, Photographer). Other companions or spectators must not enter the competition area, but remain spectators viewing area.

Registration deadline

Registration deadline is Wednesday 05th April 2017 23:59.

Drawing

The drawings will be generated on Thursday, 6th September 2017 in the evening and are uploaded on Sportdata. Due to Last Minute Registrations and modifications there might be changes in the drawings. For registered Coaches we will print the latest drawings directly at the competition.

Rules

According to the rules of World Karate Federation (WKF) & Swiss Karate Federation (SKF) with small adjustments (see below).

Liability

Insurance is the participant's own responsibility. The organizer is excluded in any form of liability whatsoever. With the registration the participant & the Dojo-director confirm the physical and psychic health of the participant as well as the participation in the tournament without any difficulty as regards to health.

Participation

Multiple starts are only allowed in Kumite (the own weight-category as well as the open-category).





Accreditation of athletes, coaches, officials, press and photographers

All athletes and coaches as well as officials, press and photographers have to be accredited. Without accreditation there is strictly no access to the competition area. Athletes are not able to start their competition without accreditation.

For accreditation, the following dates are reserved:

- Friday, 7th April 2017 from 18:00 to 21:00
- Saturday, 8th April 2017 from 07:30 to 12:00
- -> Accreditation for Kata-Cateogries have to be completed until 08:00

The athletes must register before the competition in the above accreditation time windows. No accreditations are possible outside the accreditation period. Non-accredited athletes are excluded from the competition without reimbursement of the start fee. The organizer is not liable for late accreditations and missed starts!

Process of accreditation:

- The coaches enter the accreditation area together with their athletes
- Optional application of last minute registrations and modifications
- Payment of registration fees for the entire club/school (please bring your payment receipt with you)
- Accreditation of the individual athletes (passport control, weight control)
- Handout of the individual athletes or coach cards

Each club gets a coach card per 5 participants (max. 5 coaches per club). After the accreditation the coach receives additional information about the competition (e.g. modified draws).

Access to the competition area is only granted for owners of athletes- or coach-cards, wearing Karate Gi or track suit as well as other accredited persons (officials, press, photographer). Other companions or spectators must not enter the competition area, but remain in the spectators viewing area.

Referees

Each referee must be registered on Sportdata with the appropriate level (International WKF & EKF, national A, B, C). The following expenses will be applied (per day):

National A	CHF 120
National B & C	CHF 80
Juniors	CHF 50

Responsible referee

Nomination of a main responsible referee will be at the beginning of the Swiss Junior Open.

Protest

Protests have to be justified and handed in to the main jury table in written form, simultaneously, a deposit of CHF 200.- will be paid up front. Should the protest be approved, the amount will be refunded.

Award ceremony

The award ceremonies will be held after each category. At the award ceremony the competitors must dress a karate Gi or a track suit. Any non-compliance will automatically lead into a disqualification.

Shobu System, repechage with Montreal-System. Qualifying round and Final with flag-system.

Different Kata in each round (until 4. Kyu, two different Katas, higher than 3. Kyu, three different Katas at least): Tokui-Kata according to the WKF list enlarged with Heian, Pinan, Geki-Sai-Ichi, Geki-Sai Ni. Repetition of Kata is allowed in Final oder decisions on third place.

During the qualifying round the athletes present their Katas at the same time. Only during the finals the athletes present their Kata one after another.

Equipment

White Karate-Gi (an emblem of the club on the left side is permitted). Contact lenses and eyeglasses can be worn at one's own risk. Headscarf/Bandanna (WKF-approved) is allowed





KATATEAM Categories U10, U14, 14+

Should there be less than 4 athletes in one category, they will automatically be classified in the next higher category of the same age. If the category is already the highest category, then the athletes will automatically be classified in the next lower category. Each winner is obligated to inform the responsible tournament table immediately after each round.

During the qualifying and the finals the athletes present their Kata one after another. There is no Bunkai.

White Karate Gi (an emblem of the club on the left side is permitted). Contact lenses and Spectacles can be worn at one's own risk. Headscarf/Bandanna (WKF-approved) is allowed



KUMITE Categories U12, U14, U16, U18 and U21

The weight categories will be determined on the basis of the registrations. Therefore, the <u>exact body weight</u> needs to be declared in the registration form on Sportdata. Athletes who did not enter their exact body weight will start in the category with the heaviest competitors. The enrolled weight will be controlled at accreditation. If the measured weight is not in the tolerance (U10, U12, U14: +/- 3000 Gramm, U16 and higher: +/- 100 Gramm), the athletes category has to be changed. This will be a last minute change and will cost CHF 25.

Should there be less than 4 athletes in one category, they will automatically be classified in the next higher category of the same age. If the category is already the highest category, then the athletes will automatically be classified in the next lower category.

Duration:

U10, U12 and U14:	1 ½ minutes actual fighting time
U16, U18 and U21:	2 minutes actual fighting time
Head (Jodan):	No contact/touch permitted (fist and foot techniques).
Belly / Back (Chudan):	Light touch of the Karate Gi is permitted but no contact with the body.

Equipment

White Karate-Gi (an emblem of the club on the left side is permitted) with red and blue belt. Contact lenses can be worn at one's own risk. Eyeglasses are forbidden in all Kumite categories! Face guard is not permitted!

Obligatory for U10, U12 and U14:

- Official red and blue fist protection (WKF/SKF-approved)
- > Official red and blue foot protection (WKF/SKF-approved)
- Dental protection/Mouth Guard

Allowed for U10, U12 and U14:

- Groin Guard for male participants
- Breast protector for female participants
- > Chest protector for male and female participants
- Official red and blue shin guard (WKF/SKF-approved)
- Headscarf/Bandanna (WKF-approved)

Obligatory for U16, U18 und U21:

- Official red and blue fist protection (WKF/SKF-approved)
- Official red and blue foot protection (WKF/SKF-approved)
- Dental protection/Mouth Guard
- Groin Guard for male participants
- Breast protector for female participants
- Chest protector for male and female participants
- Official red and blue shin guard (WKF/SKF-approved)
